Rendezvous: In vicinity of Annapolis Area Mark "X".

Start: Between orange flag on RC boat and a large inflatable red mark.

Finish: Between orange flag on RC boat and a large inflatable red mark.

Course: Drop mark type courses or as designated by letters displayed on RC boat.

Signals: RRS 26 (Starting Races) is changed as shown below.

Note: If any start is subject to a general recall or is postponed, each class will start at 5-minute intervals after the recalled or postponed start in the order specified above.

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR SUNDAY: Subsequent races will be started for each class individually. About 1 minute before the warning signal for each subsequent race, the course for the class to start will be designated and multiple horns sounded. This is not a timed signal.

IRC Scoring: For Saturday's handicap classes, the Race Committee will provide courtesy IRC scoring within each PHRF class for any boat with a valid IRC rating certificate. Trophies and scoring for CBYRA High Point will be under PHRF only. If you wish a courtesy IRC score, please indicate your IRC rating on your entry form. Although not required at the time of submitting your entry, IRC rating certificates must be provided by any competitor wishing to be scored under IRC on request of the Race Committee.

Time Limit: 1700 on both days. Boats failing to finish by 1700 hours will be scored Did Not Finish. This changes RRS 35 and A4.1.

Protests: Due on Race Day at the CBYRA Office, 612 Third Street, Annapolis, MD within 2 hours of the protesting boat's finish, but not later than 1900 hours. Heard starting at 2000 hours on Thursday April 27, 2006 at the CBYRA Office.

Other: Race Committee will monitor VHF 77 and will attempt to notify premature starters.

Awards: 5 starters or less, 1st place only; 5-7 starters, 1st and 2nd place; 9 or more starters, 1st, 2nd and 3rd place. Preliminary and final results will be posted online as soon as possible at: <http://www.usna.edu/Sailing/races/races.html> and by CBYRA. Awards will be mailed.

Social: Because access to the Naval Academy is restricted, there will be no open house this year.
