

<u>Directions to the Stadium</u>: From U.S. Route 50
East, take exit 24 Rowe Blvd; from U.S. Route 50
West, take exit 24A Rowe Blvd. Turn right on to
Taylor Ave. The stadium will be on the right.
Use Gate 5 for USNA Shuttle parking.

At USNA:

On weekdays, only drivers with DOD ID cards, Midshipmen Parent Passes, or handicapped placards are permitted access to the Yard. Access is further limited during the Blue Angels Flight Demonstration and Color Parade.



Walking Directions from Stadium to USNA through Gate 8: For a 15-30 minute walk to USNA, the easiest route is to head east on Taylor Ave., cross Rowe Blvd., and turn right on Annapolis St./ Rte. 450. Cross King George St. and USNA Gate 8 will be ahead on the right.


